



MS 04: Frew Collection [2018.3]

This is a large, unprocessed collection of material donated by Colleen Frew in late 2017, mainly concerning the Frew family in Enfield from the late 19th century up through the 1970s. Additional material on the history of the town included. Collection highlights from accession form:

- 10 scrapbooks from the 1890s through the 1970s
- Robert H. Frew diary, 1922-36, seven volumes
- Photo albums, persons not identified, likely 1920s
- Clothing, including military uniform, linen suit, and early EHS baseball uniform
- Various town documents, including annual reports, commencement programs, zoning ordinances
- An envelope of papers from the state's acquisition of Frew property for the 1964 construction of Route 190 and the Enfield-Suffield Bridge. Includes map of properties.
- Taylor-Chillson family tree
- 1929 map of Clarence Martin property in Hazardville
- Railroad and trolley ticket stubs
- Framed photos, most without labels
